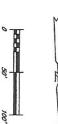

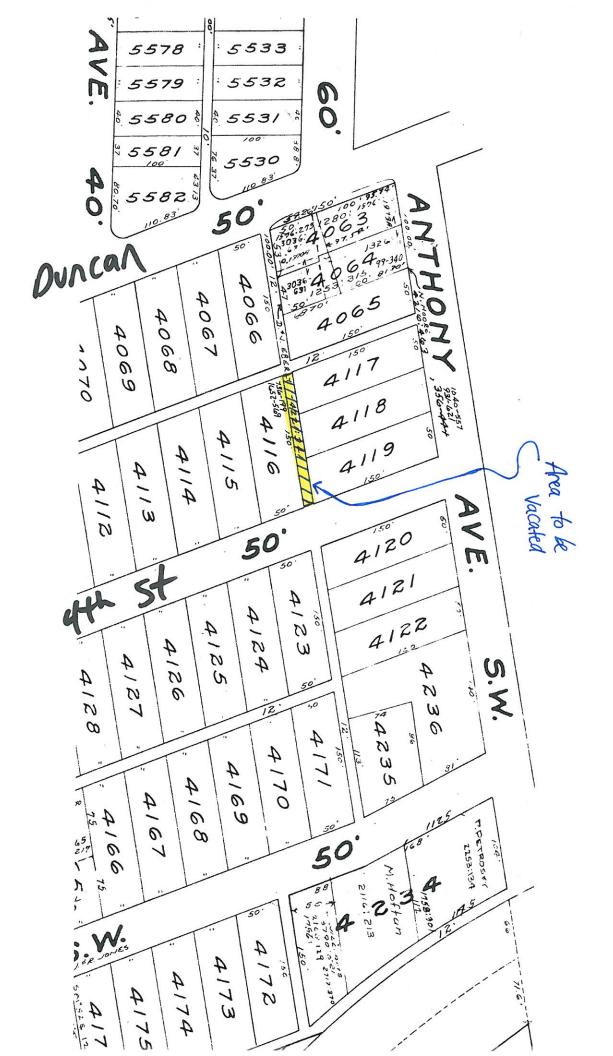

Massillon Planning Commission February 9, 2010

The Massillon Planning Commission met in regular session on February 9, 2011 at 4:30 p.m. in Mayor Cicchinelli's office. The following were present:

Members

Vice-Chairman Todd Locke Mayor Francis H. Cicchinelli, Jr. Safety-Service Director Mike Loudiana Susan Saracina Frank Cilona Bob Maurer Staff

The first item of business was approval of the minutes for the Commission meeting of November 10, 2010. Director Loudiana moved for approval, seconded by Mayor Cicchinelli, the motion unanimously carried.

Mr. Aaby then introduced Mr. Bob Maurer as the new member of the Planning Commission.

The next item under new business was the rezoning of the Sibila Family LLC Annexation property presented by Mr. Aaby.

Rezoning - Sibila Family LLC Annexation

Property Description: Out Lots 1097 and 1098, a 10.54 acre area located along the east side of Valerie Avenue NE, north of Hankins Road..

Zone Change From: Perry Township, R-2 Single and Two Family Residential

Zone Change To: R-3 Single Family Residential

Applicant: City of Massillon

Proposed Use: Property was recently annexed to the City of Massillon and need to give this property a zoning classification under the Massillon Zoning regulations.

Mr. Aaby stated that this property is a 10.54 acre parcel located east of Valerie and north of Hankins with two buildings. It was annexed into the City last year from Perry Township and now requires a Massillon City zoning. He proposed R-3 Single Family Residential zoning, which are 12,000 square foot lots.

Mayor Cicchinelli asked if that zoning coincides with what was already in place. Mr. Aaby replied that yes, it was zoned R-2 Single and Two Family Residential in Perry Township. Mayor Cicchinelli stated that the zoning that is proposed is for Single Family Residential only.

Mr. Locke abstained from voting. With no further comments or questions, Mayor Cicchinelli moved for approval, seconded by Mrs. Saracina, the motion unanimously carried.

The next item was a replat request presented by Mr. Aaby.

Replat - Habitat for Humanity

Location: Lots 4138 and 4140, located on the southeast corner of 4th Street SW and McKinley Ave SW. The request is to replat these properties into one new lot, 0.2838 acres in size. The property is zoned R-1 Single Family.

Applicant: Habitat for Humanity of Stark and Carroll Counties

Mr. Aaby stated that Habitat has built five homes in the Columbia Heights area. They have acquired these lots on the corner of 4th Street and McKinley Avenue SW that form a triangular piece due to the railroad right-of-way that runs through the back of the properties. Their request is to replat the three portions of lots into one buildable lot.

Mr. Cilona asked if the replat would meet the setback requirements on the short side of the triangular lot. Mr. Aaby stated that a house would fit on the lot and that no variances would be needed to meet the setback requirements. Mr. Aaby stated that R-1 Single Family zoning requires 7,800 square foot lots, and that the lot being created would be ¼ acre in size, which exceeds the requirement.

Mr. Maurer abstained from voting. With no further comments or questions, Mr. Cilona moved for approval, seconded by Mayor Cicchinelli, the motion unanimously carried.

The next item was a dedication plat presented by Mr. Aaby.

Dedication Plat - Sterilite Street SE Extension

Location: Out Lot 717 and Part of Out Lot 753, a 0.835 acre parcel that would extend existing Sterilite Street SE approximately 177 feet to the south and 192 feet to the west. The property is zoned I-1 Light Industrial.

Applicant: Massillon Development Foundation

Mr. Aaby stated that Sterilite Street runs south of Navarre Road into the NeoCom Industrial Park. MDF is proposing to extend Sterilite Street into the Stark County Farm property which is part of the Perry-Navarre JEDD who has received a grant from the State of Ohio for road improvements to access the County Farm property.

Bob Sanderson of MDF and Barb Bennett of Hammontree & Associates were present to answer any questions. Mr. Aaby stated that the plat as presented shows the roadway extension ending at the City's Corporation line and asked if there were plans to extend it beyond that area. Mr. Sanderson replied that the proposed roadway will extend beyond the City Corporation limits. Mrs. Bennett stated that the proposed dedication was the first of three plats needed to extend the roadway. The proposed extension involves not only the City of Massillon, but Stark County, the Wheeling Lake Erie Railroad and the City of Navarre; however it is all one road plan and one construction project. The objective is to build an access bridge over the railroad tracks that run through the site. Mrs. Bennett stated that this will be a \$2.5 improvement project.

Mr. Aaby stated that this issue is a recommendation from the Planning Commission to approve the Dedication, that accepting the Dedication would need a Council vote.

With no further comments or questions, Mayor Cicchinelli moved to approve the recommendation of the Dedication Plat for Sterilite Street S.E., seconded by Mrs. Saracina, the motion unanimously carried.

The final item on the agenda under Other Business was the election of officers for 2011.

Mayor Cicchinelli moved that Vice-Chairman Locke assume the duties of Chairman, and Mrs. Saracina assume the duties of Vice-Chairman, seconded by Mr. Cilona, motion unanimously carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:50 p.m.
