

### Massillon Planning Commission May 18, 2011

The Massillon Planning Commission met on May 18, 2011 at 4:30 p.m. in Mayor Cicchinelli's office. The following were present:

The first item of business was approval of the minutes for the Commission meeting of February 6, 2011. Mayor Cicchinelli moved for approval, seconded by Mrs. Saracina, the motion unanimously carried.

The next item under new business was a request to replat property located on Merino Circle NE presented by the property owner, Mrs. Denise Dixon.

### Replat - Merino Circle NE

Location: Lots 12870 and 14330, located on the north side of Merino Circle NE, and the south side of Springhaven Circle NE. The request is to replat these properties into two lots, one containing the exiting home and the other as a vacant lot. The property is zoned R-3 Single Family. Applicant: Denise Dixon

Mrs. Dixon stated that it was her intention to replat her properties into two lots in order to sell the extra lot. They have been replatted in such a way that the trees remain on her lot so that she will be able to protect them.

Jason Haines stated that the new lot would have to meet set-back requirements which should not be a problem as it is creating a half-acre lot.

Mayor Cicchinelli asked if the house on the new lot would front Springhaven and if there have been any soil testing done. Mrs. Dixon replied that yes, the new home would front Springhaven and that no, there has not been any soil testing done. She expressed that there has not been any interest in buying the lot as it has not yet been marketed.

Mayor Cicchinelli stated that the new house must be compatible with the existing homes in the area.

With no further comments or questions, Mayor Cicchinelli moved for approval, seconded by Mrs. Saracina, the motion unanimously carried.

The next item was an easement plat request from Aqua Ohio presented by Jason Haines.

### Easement Plat - Valerie Avenue NE

Location: Out Lot 554, locate on the East side of Valerie Ave, north of Hankins Road. The request is to grant a 20' easement for waterline construction along the east side of the roadway. The property is zoned R-3 Single Family and is the site of Wales Park. Applicant: Aqua Ohio Water/City of Massillon

Jason Haines stated that it was the intention of Aqua Ohio to extend a water line 950 feet on the east side of Valerie, starting at Hankins Road. Because the right-of-way is narrow, a 20 foot easement on the City-owned property is needed for construction.

Mr. Don Snyder was present to represent Aqua Ohio. Mr. Snyder stated that there are no hydrants available to protect four homes in this area.

Mayor Cicchinelli asked if this project was due to the recent annexation in the area. Mr. Snyder replied that no, it was not.

With no further comments or questions, Mr. Maurer moved for approval, seconded by Mrs. Saracina, the motion unanimously carried.

The next item was an alley vacation request presented by Mr. Aaby.

### Alley Vacation Plat - 4th Street SW

Location: Known as a12 foot wide public alley lying between Anthony Ave. SW and Isabella Avenue SW, and running in a west-east direction between Duncan St. SW and 4<sup>th</sup> St. SW. The request is to vacate that portion beginning at 4<sup>th</sup> Street and going westerly approximately 150 feet. Applicant: Richard A. Lemon/Tony J. Smith

Mr. Aaby stated that the alley is currently open and can be driven through between Duncan Street and 4<sup>th</sup> Street, but that Mr. Lemon does not want to vacate the western part of the alley.

Mr. Lemon was there to represent his request. Mr. Lemon stated that the alley is a mud hole after the winter and that the City does not maintain it. It is his intention to build a garage on his property and to place a fence across the alley to cut off access to traffic.

Mr. Maurer asked if the alley would be split between the property owners. Mr. Lemon stated that it would, but there would be an easement agreement between the property owners to share access.

Mr. Locke asked if there were any safety or service questions. There were none.

Mr. Haines stated that this request must be approved by Council.

Mayor Cicchinelli asked if Mr. Lemon's councilman was aware of this request. Mr. Lemon stated that yes, Donnie Peters was aware of it.

With no further comments or questions, Mayor Cicchinelli moved for approval, seconded by Mrs. Saracina, the motion unanimously carried.

There being no further business, Mayor Cicchinelli moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Maurer, the motion unanimously carried. The meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m.
