What's going on here?

An old train trestle-turned-footbridge along the Sippo Valley Trail is being rebuilt following an arson in 2008. The support posts are being cut off, replaced and covered with a metal sleeve. New poles will be placed over the top of them. Workers then will install new

Whose project is it?

The Massillon Area Greenways spearheaded the project shortly after the arson. It has sponsored several fundraising events, including poker bicycle runs, to raise money for the project. MAGI is working with the city of Massillon Parks and Recreation Department on

What's the cost?

\$60,000. The Ohio and Eric Canalway Association supplied a \$20,000 matching grant for the project this summer. The rest of the project is being paid for through fundraisers and personal and corporate contributions.

When will it be done?

The work will take six to eight weeks to complete, so it could be done by mid-to-late-November.

Who's doing the work on project?

723.55 Restriction upon contract to construct or repair bridges.

A municipality shall not contract for or undertake construction or repair of a bridge, for which the cost of such work exceeds fifty thousand dollars, unless the plans are prepared or approved by a professional engineer qualified in the designing of bridges.
