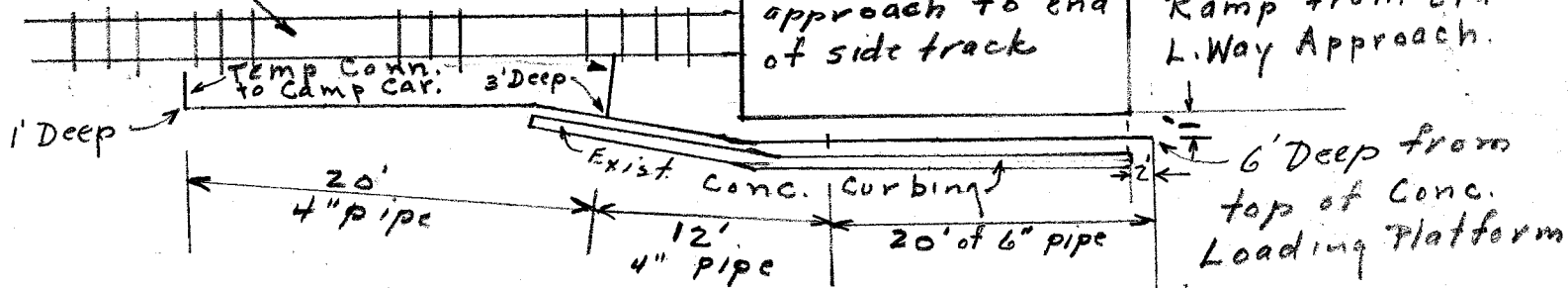

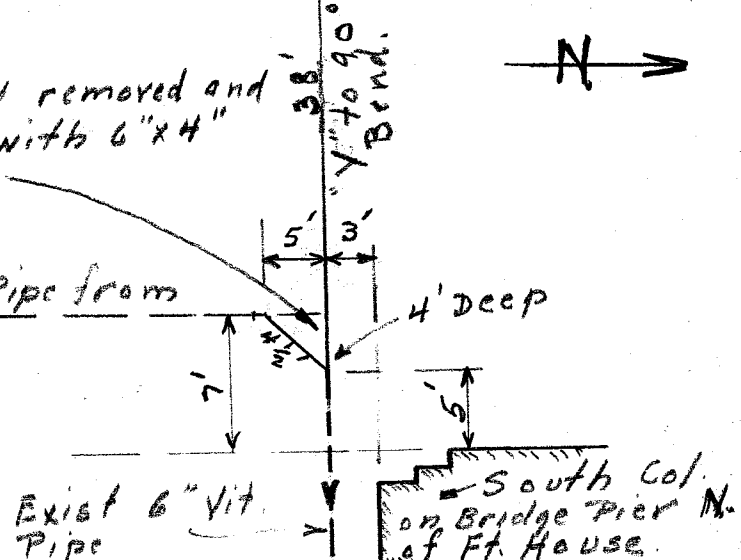


6" x 4" Lateral Vit Pipe
