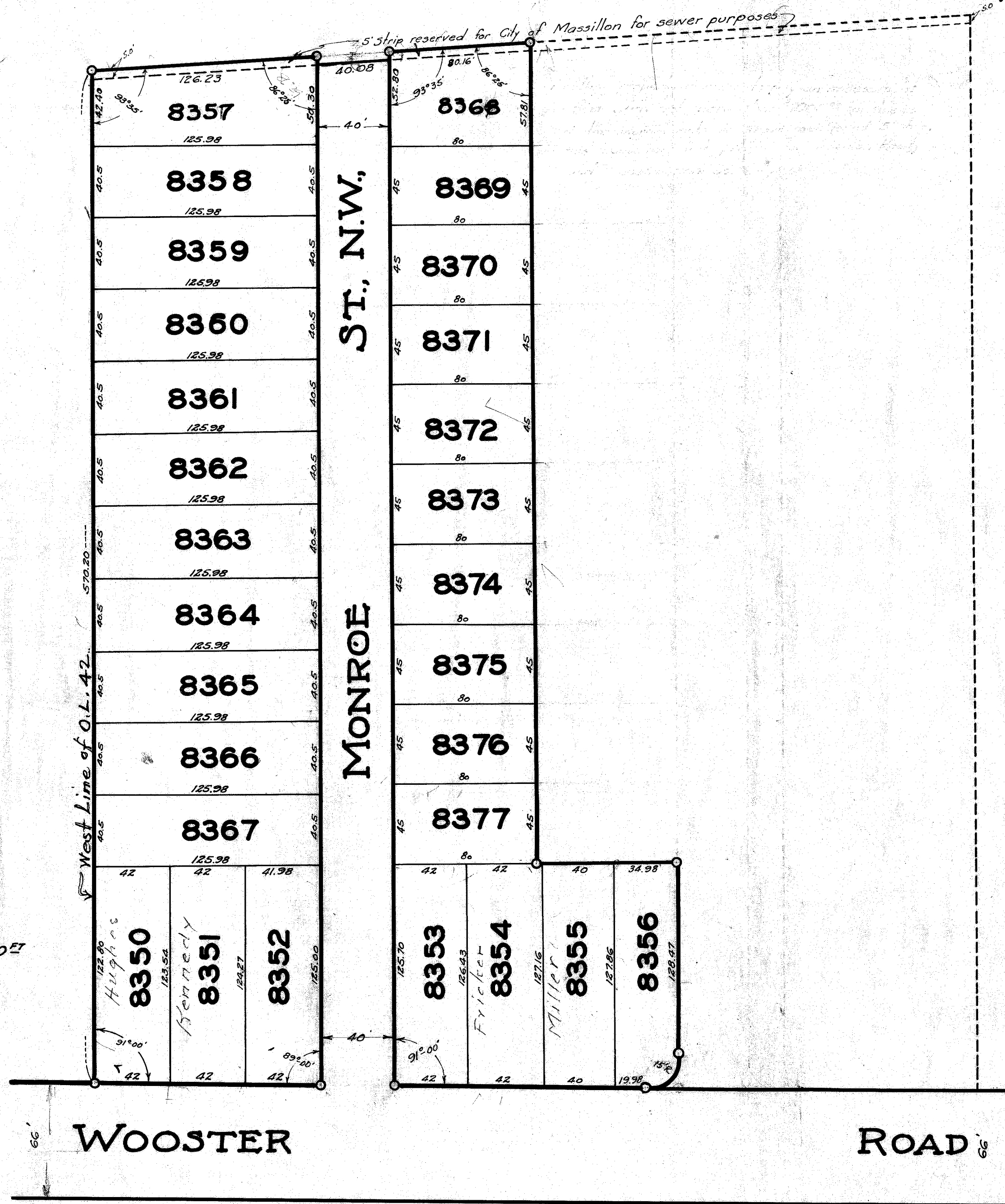


DIEFFENBACHER ALLOTMENT
