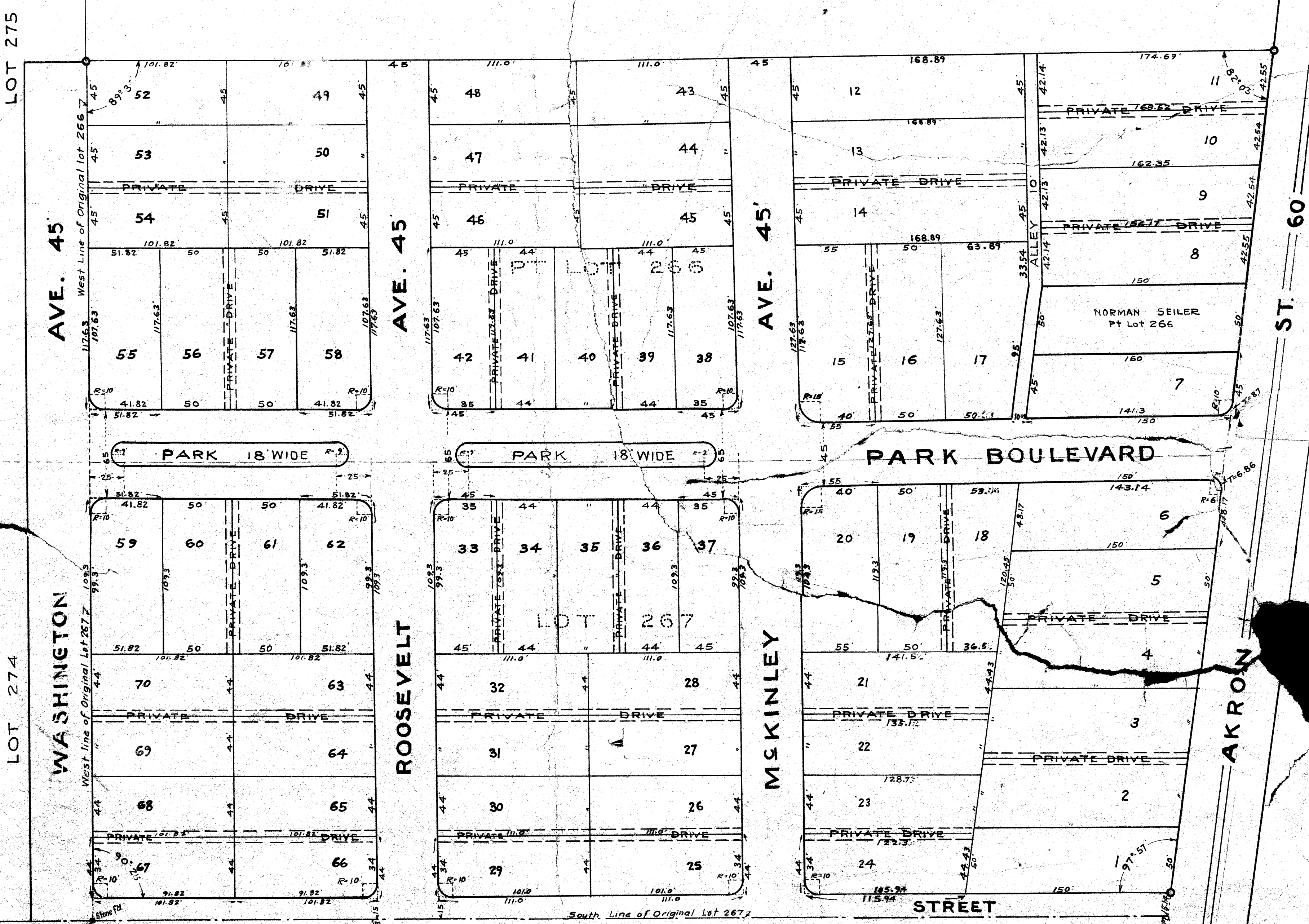


# KORMANN HEIGHTS
