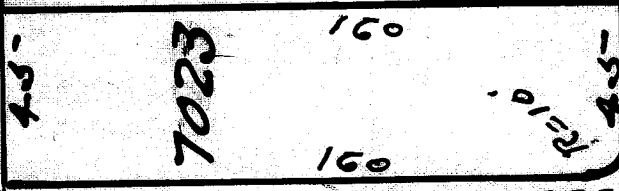
12' Alley



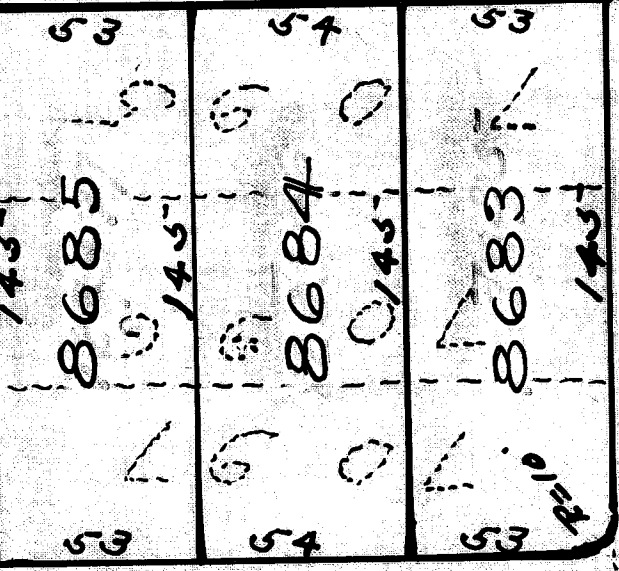
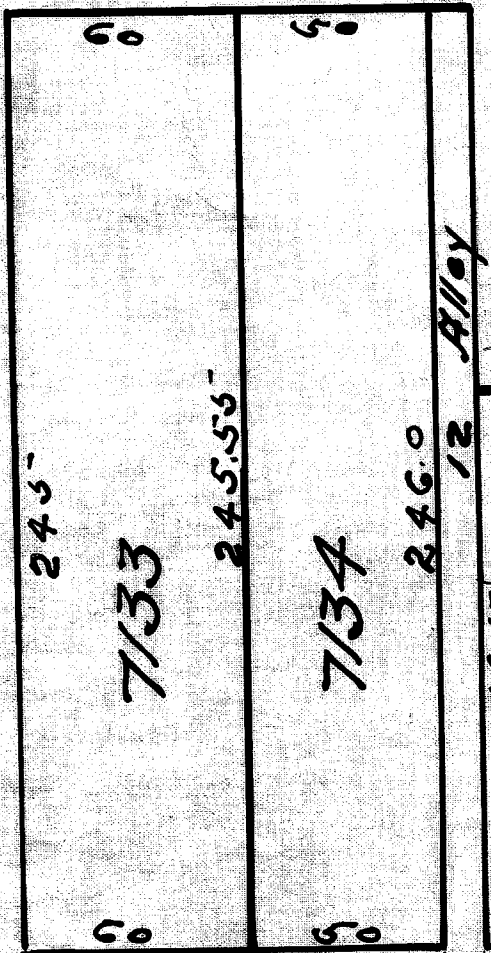
