of part of Lot 32

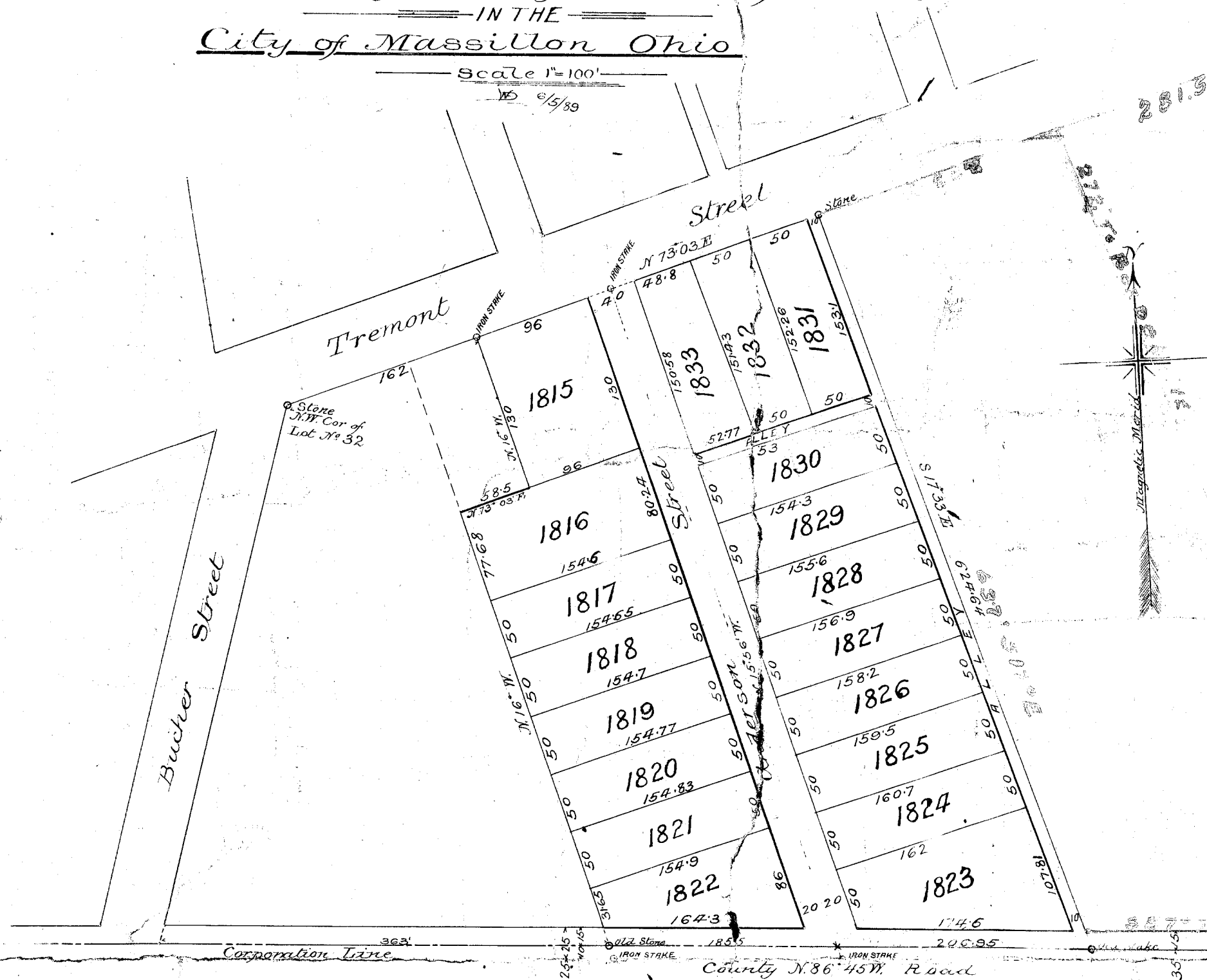
In Wetmore Binney and Fay's amicable partition

We Eugene Anderson and Anna Maria Stephens the owners and proprietors of the following lands situate in the City of Massillon, Stark County Ohio, as follows; Part of Lot 32 according to a certain map or plat of an amicable partition of lands made by W. S. Wetmore, R. S. Fay and Executors of the Estate of Amos Binney, and bounded and described as follows, Beginning at a point 162 ft; easterly along the north side of said lot; from the North west corner of the same, thence N 73° 03' E, along the south line of Tremont Street 294.8 ft; thence S 17° 33' E, 624.64 ft; to the north side of a county road known as the Silk road, thence N 86° 45' W along said north line 392 ft; thence N 16° 00' W, 359.33 ft; to the Southwest corner of a lot owned by Nicholas Wallbold, thence N 73° 03' E, 58.5 ft to the Southeast corner of said Wallbold's lot, thence N 16° 00' W, 130 ft; along said Wallbold's east line, to the place of beginning; Comprising the Subdivision delineated on this map; do hereby acknowledge the same to be our act and deed and we do hereby dedicate the streets and alleys to the public use forever.
