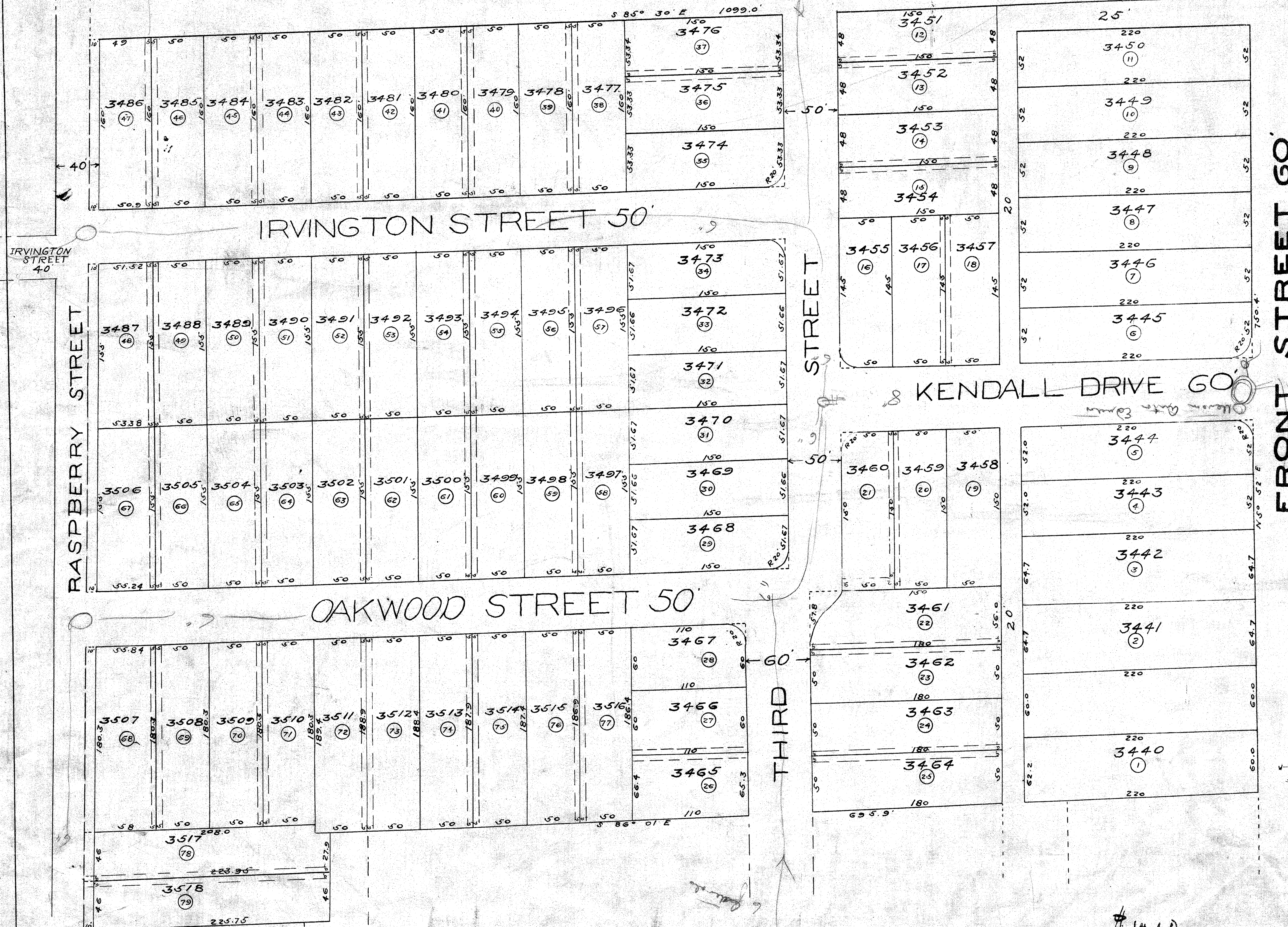


KENDALL PLACE
