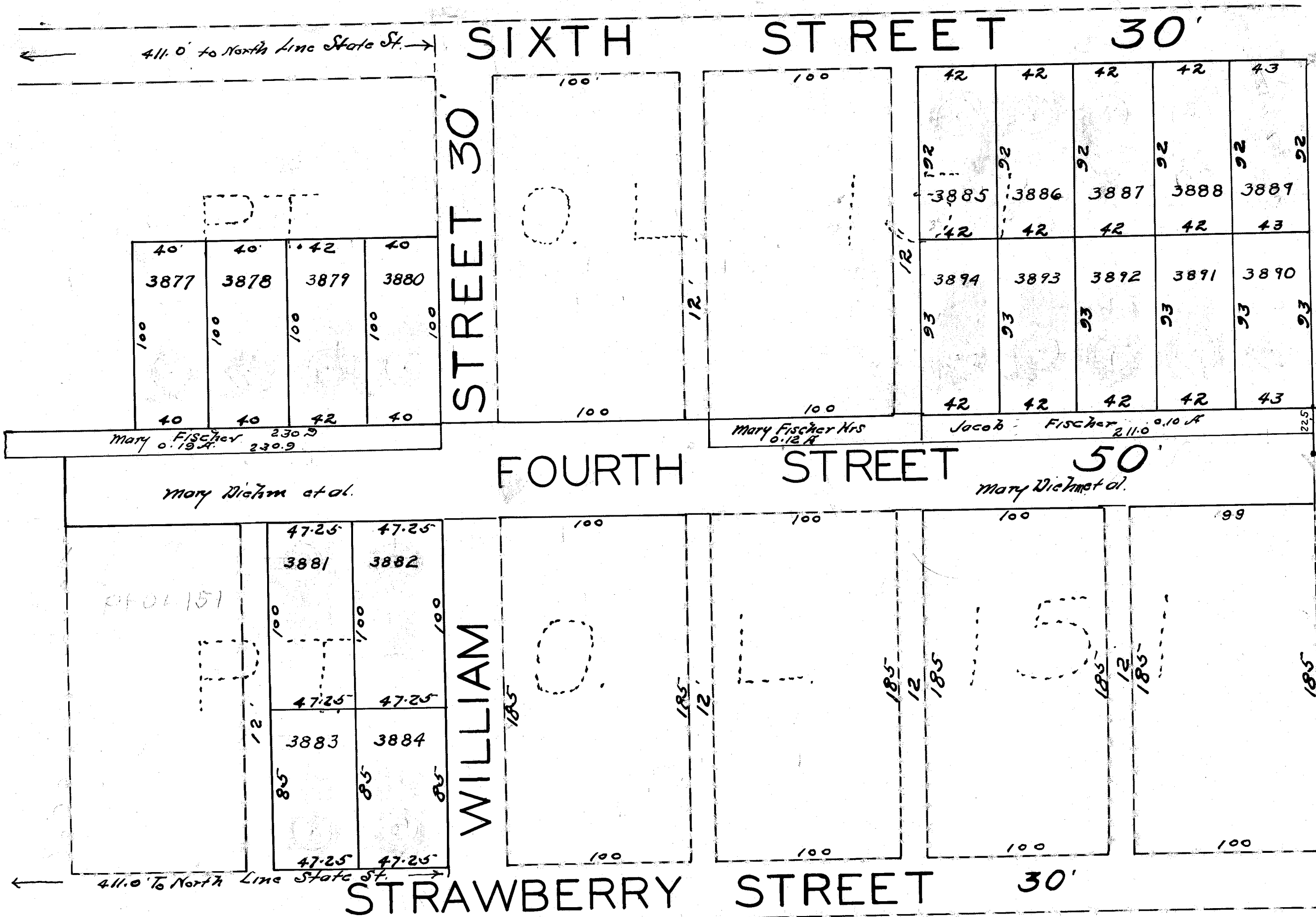


BLACET'S SUBDIVISION PART OUTLOT NO. 151 IN THE CITY OF MASSILLON, O.
