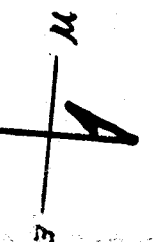


MILLER & SNYDER ADDITION

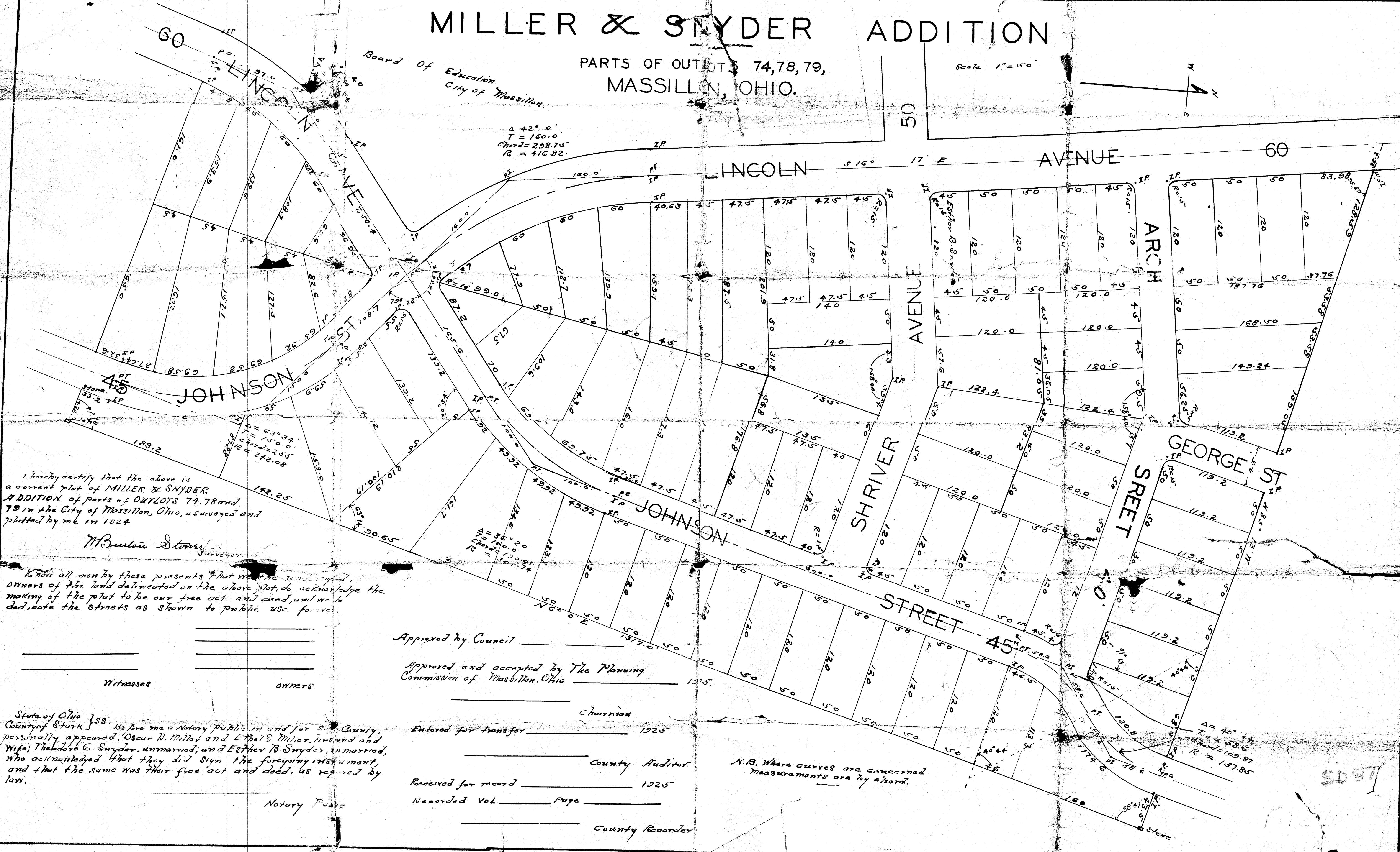
PARTS OF OUTLOTS 74, 78, 79,
