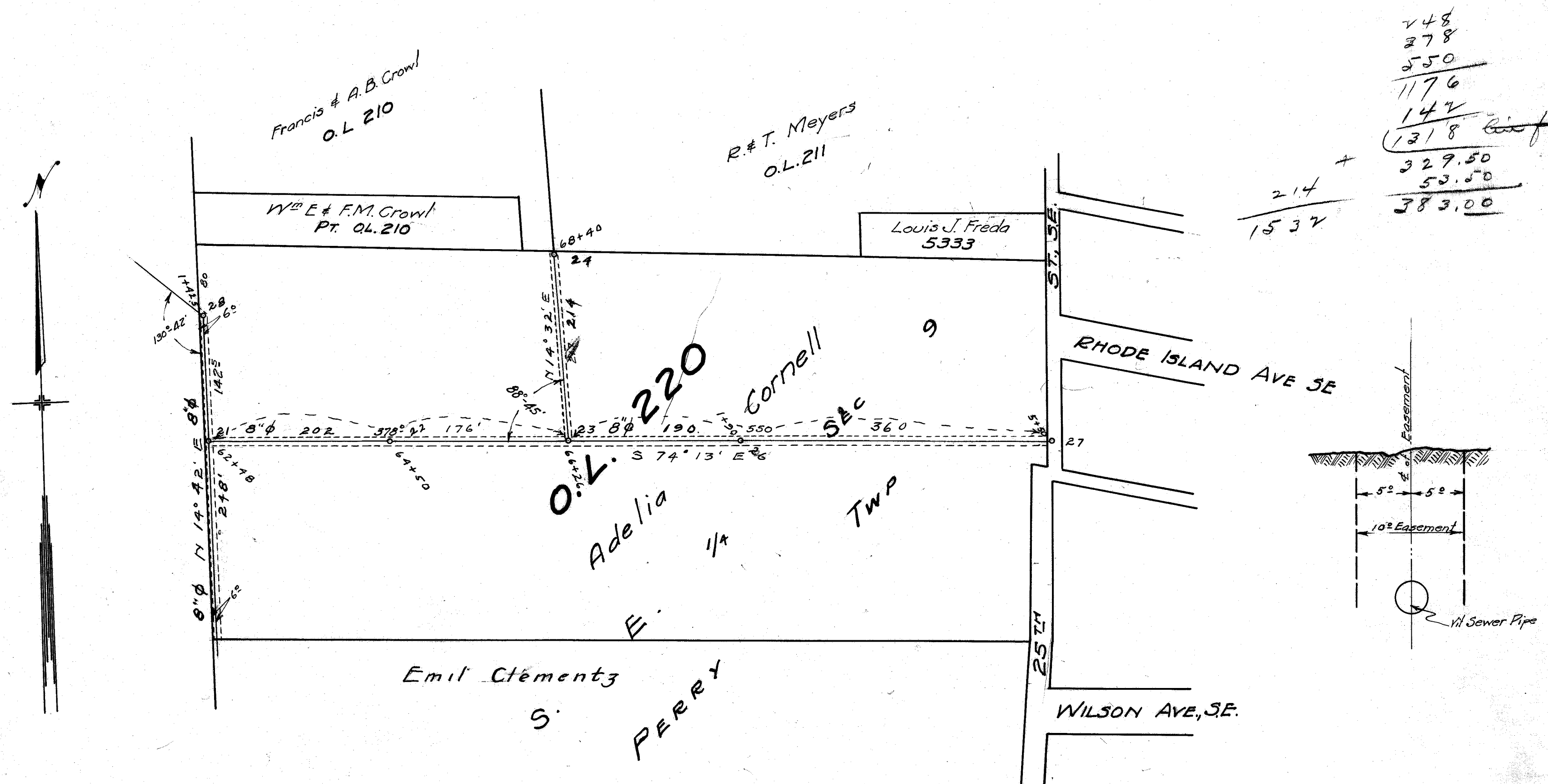




GRANT

The undersigned, owners of the lands hereon shown (SE 1/4 Sec 9) for the consideration of Twenty five Cents (\$25) per ft. and other considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey to the City of Massillon, Ohio, and its successors, the right to construct and forever maintain in and on said land, a sanitary sewer of eight (8) inches or less inside dia. to be situated within a strip of land ten (10) feet wide and with center line shown hereon.

Further, that the City and its agents may have the temporary use of, for construction purposes on additional strip of land fifty (50) feet wide and parallel to and adjoining the easement aforesaid.
