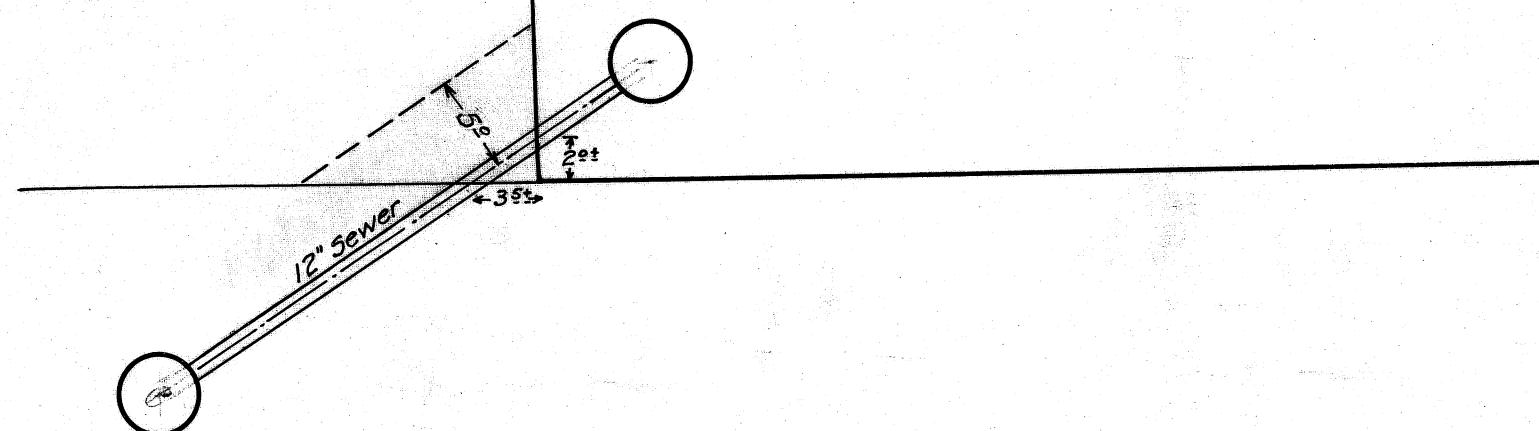

GRANT

The undersigned owner of the lands hereon shown (Lot #814) for the consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other considerations receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey to the City of Massillon, Ohio, and its successors, the right to construct and forever maintain in and on said land, a storm sewer of twelve (12) inches or less inside dia. to be situated within a strip of land ten (10) feet wide and with center line shown hereon.

Further that the City and its agents may have the temporary use of, for construction purpose on additional strip of land ten (10) feet wide and parallel to and adjoining the easement aforesaid.

Provided, however, that said City shall save the grantee and her successors in title, free and harmless from any loss or damage caused by the future operation of said sewer. Provided, also that the City of Massillon survey and stake the Lot (#814) on which the sewer is situated, free of charge, and pay her attorney's fee, of \$5.00
