Prevailing Winds:—Southwest.

PAVING:—About 30 miles paved streets.
GRADES:—Slightly rolling.

WATER FACILITIES

Gravity and direct pressure system owned by the Ohio Water Service Co. Supply from wells. One 550,000 gallon and one 200,000 gallon standpipe, elevated 100' above corner of Main and Erie Sts. 2 pumping stations.

LOW SERVICE PUMPS.—1 Blake, capacity 2,000,000 gallons per day. 1 Worthington, capacity 500 gallons per minute. 1 Dunham, capacity 1,500,000 gallons per day. 1 Peerless, capacity 2,000,000 to 3,000,000 gallons per day.

HIGH SERVICE PUMPS.—1 DeLaval, capacity 2,500,000 gallons per day. 1 DeLaval, capacity 1,500,000 gallons per day. 1 Peerless 2,000,000 gallons per day.

BOOSTER PUMPS.—1 Worthington, capacity 500 gallons per minute. 1 Worthington, capacity 75 gallons per minute.

83 miles 4" to 16" water mains. 640 double and triple hydrants. Average daily consumption 1,800,000 gallons.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

1 chief and 19 men, fully paid. 8 call men, paid on call. 3 fire stations.

STATION NO. 1.—1 chief's auto. 1 Seagrave 65' aerial truck with 228' of ladders, 250 gallon booster tank and 200' 1" hose. 1 Seagrave triple combination truck, 750 gallon per minute pump, 1,000' 2½" hose, 200 gallon booster tank, 200' 1½" hose, 200' ¾" hose, 28' extension and 14' roof ladders.

IN RESERVE.—1 Diamond "T" triple combination truck, 100 gallon per minute pump, 300' 2½" hose, 120 gallon booster tank, 200' 1½" hose, 150' ¾" hose and 1,000' 2½" hose.

STATION NO. 2.—1 Seagrave triple combination truck, 750 gallon per minute pump, 1,000' 2½" hose, 200 gallon booster tank, 200' 1½" hose, 200' ¾" hose, 28' extension and 14' roof ladder. 1 Seagrave triple combination truck, 350 gallon per minute pump, 500' 2½" hose, 125 gallon booster tank, 125' ¾" hose and 1 Deluge set. In Reserve: 500' 2½" hose.

STATION NO. 3.—1 Seagrave triple combination truck, 750 gallon per minute pump, 1,000' $2\frac{1}{4}$ " hose, 150 gallon booster tank, 200' $1\frac{1}{2}$ " hose, 150' $\frac{3}{4}$ " hose, 28' extension and 14' roof ladders. In Reserve. 500' $2\frac{1}{4}$ " hose.

Gamewell fire alarm system. 66 boxes. Headquarters located at fire station No. 1, corner of Factory and Charles Sts. S. E., Ordinary brick building, two-story.

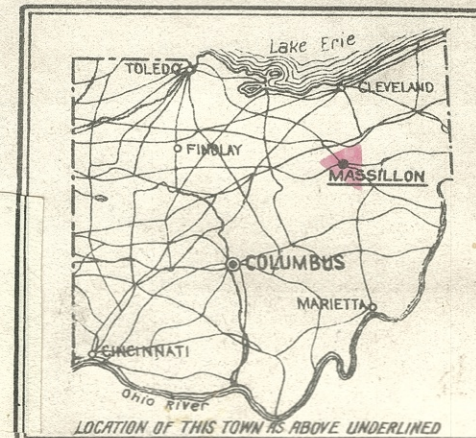
