

The Site Plan Review Committee met November 9, 1977 at 3:00 P.M. in the Engineer's Conference Room.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the site plan for the construction of a new industrial structure to house Kitchen Cooked Potatoe Chips, Inc., to be located at 1929 Ninth St. S.W. John Harris III, site plan architect, was also present at meeting.

Mayor Ross asked if there were any problems associated with the sanitary sewer system in the area.

Robert Wagoner answered that no sanitary sewer problems would be associated with the development as a new sewer system had recently been constructed to service the area. Director Sparma asked if there would be any discharge into the sanitary system from the plant.

Mr. Wagoner stated that a manhole, not shown on the site plan, should be placed above the sanitary line to check the discharge.

John Harris was of the opinion that most of the wastes used in the preparation of the potato products would be trucked away rather than discharged, but wastes might be discharged when washing equipment.

Director Sparma, instructed Mr. Harris that a meeting between Robert Bushman, sewage treatment plant superintendent, and a representative from Kitchen Cooked Potato Chips be arranged to determine exactly what the sanitary requirements are.

Mr. Bleckman stated that all zoning requirements had been met.

There being no further discussion, Director Sparma moved that the site plan be approved, seconded by Mayor Ross; motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:20 P.M.
