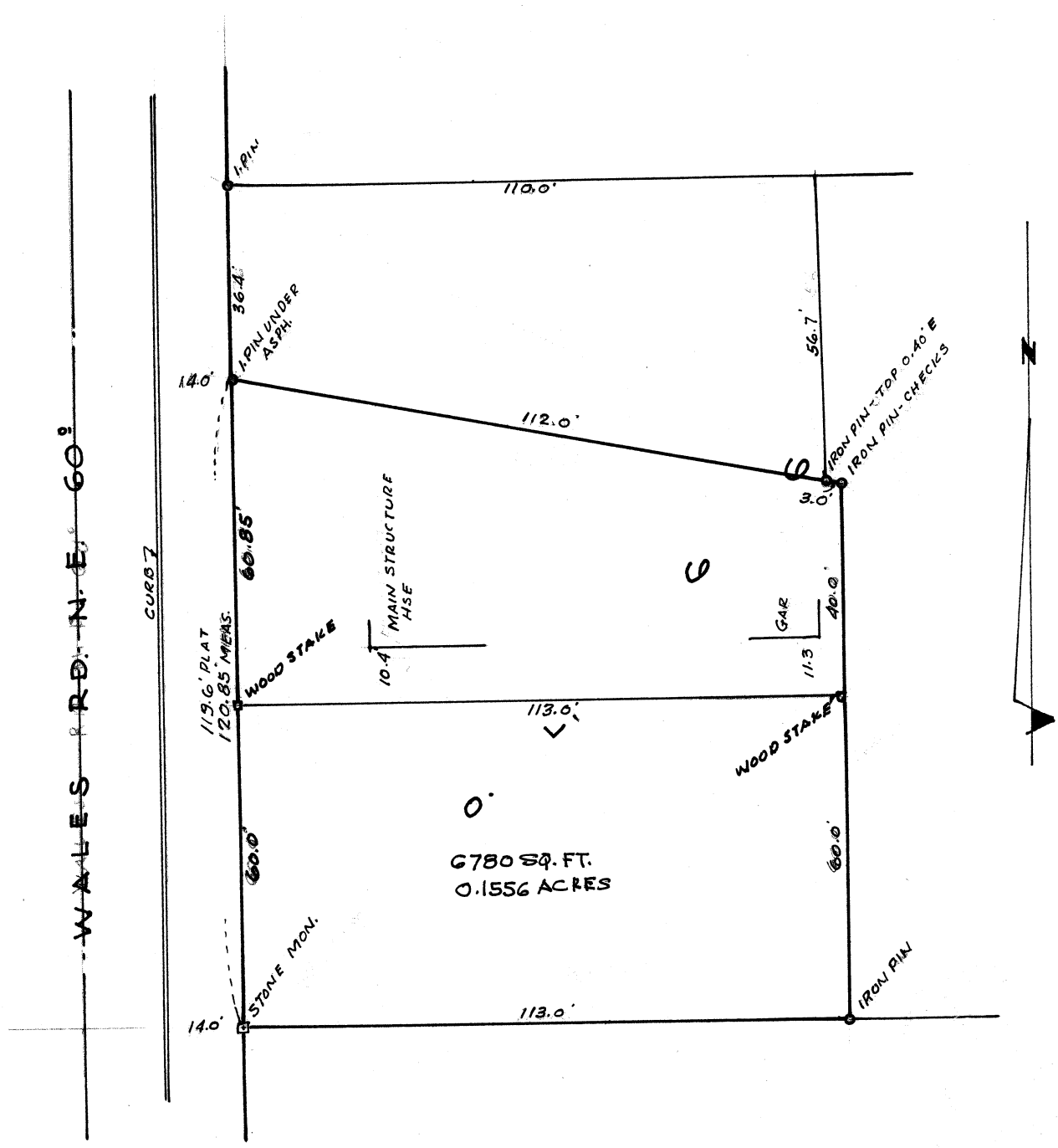

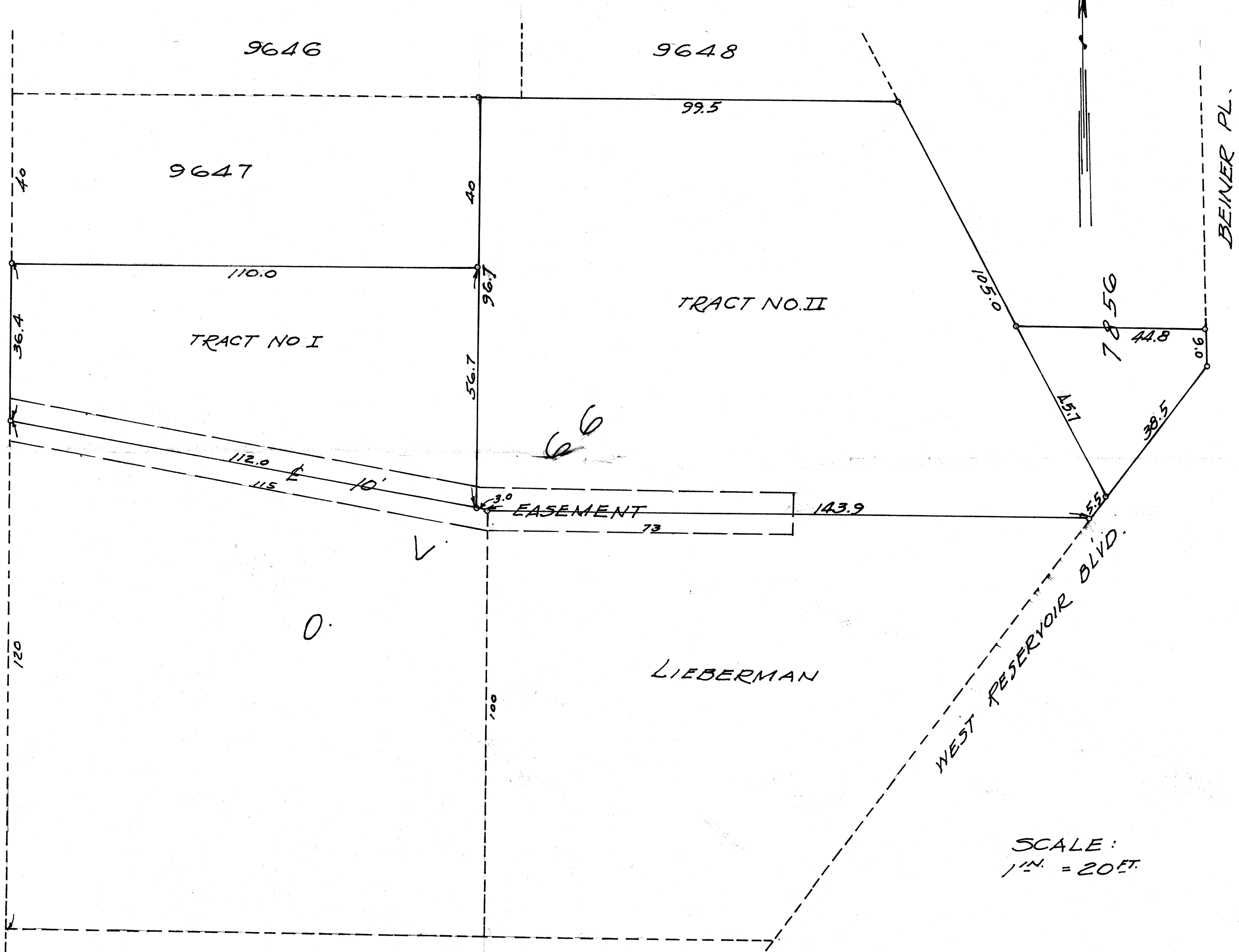

PART O.L. 66

Known as and being Part of O.L. 66 in the City of Massillon, Stark County, Ohio, and being more fully described as follows:

The true place of beginning being an existing stone monument at the southwest corner of said O.L. 66;

Thence northerly along the east right-of-way line of Wales Road N.E., 60' in width, a distance of 60.00' to a stake;

Thence easterly and parallel to the south line of said O.L. 66, a distance of 113.00' to a stake;

Thence southerly and parallel to the east right-of-way line of Wales Road N.E., a distance of 60.00' to an existing iron pin on the south line of O.L. 66;

Thence westerly along the south line of O.L. 66, a distance of 113.00' to the true place of beginning containing 6780 square feet of 0.1556 acres.
