



Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot No. 9729 said point being on the east R/W line of the Pennsylvania Railroad thence N 5°-32' E along said R/W line, also being the west line of C.L. 80 419.8 feet to the point of beginning and the said easement; thence S. 72°-04' E 4.0 feet to a point; thence N 43°-51' E 37.0 feet to a point; thence S 71°-50' E 105.0 feet to the east line of that Pt. of C.L. 80 owned by the Chio Water Service Company, said point being 89.6 feet south of the northeast corner thereof.

Thence NO°20'30"W along the western boundary line of Third St., NW a distance of 411.56' to a point;

Thence N6°36'30"W along the western boundary line of Third St., NW a distance of 89.54° to the true place of beginning of the tract herein described; said point being the northeast corner of a parcel described in Vol. 2168, Pg. 501, Stark County Records;

Thence N89°12'10"W along the northern boundary line of said parcel described in Vol. 2168, Pg. 501, a distance of 258.88' to an existing iron pin at the northeast corner of a parcel described in Vol. 1170, Pg. 6, Stark County Records;


Thence N89°08'30"W along the northern boundary line of said parcel described in Vol. 1170, Pg. 6, a distance of 130.00' to an existing iron pin;

Thence N6°44'10"E along the eastern boundary line of the Pennsylvania Railroad a distance of 592.00' to the southwest corner of a parcel described in Vol. 2670, Pg. 557, Stark County Records;

Thence 389°11'40"E along the southern boundary line of said parcel described in Vol. 2670, Pg. 557, a distance of 251.09' to the southeast corner of said parcel:

Thence 56°36'30"E along the western boundary of Third St., N.W. a distance of 593.89' to the true place of beginning, containing 4.326 acres.

The following described premises situated in the City of Massillon, County of Stark, State of Ohio and known as:

Being a part of Out Lot Number Eighty (80) in said City of Massillon and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the north west corner of said Lot 80, thence along the north line of Lot 80 and the south line of "Paul Drive" North eighty degrees and sixteen minutes East (N80°-16'E) one hundred three and seven tenths (103.7) feet to an iron pin at the northeast corner of Lot 80 thence, along the east line of said Lot and the west line of Third Street North West in said City south seven degrees and twelve minutes East (S79-12'E) six hundred fifty (650) feet to an iron pin, thence north eightynine degrees and forty-seven minutes west (N89°-47'W) two hundred fifty and six tenths (250.6) feet to an iron pin on the west line of said Lot 80 being the east line of Out Lot number nine (9) and the east right-of-way line of the Pittsburgh Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroad Company and thence along said east right of way line North six degrees and six minutes east (N6°-6'E) six hundred thirty (630) feet to the point of beginning containing an area of two and fiftyeight hundredths (2.58) acres.
