

Stark County, Ohio according to the present numbering of lots in
said City, and being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the true place of beginning of the tract herein
to be conveyed, said point being the intersection of the west line
of 3rd St. S. E. and the south line of Nettmore Ave. S. E.; thence
southerly along the west line of 3rd St. S. E. a distance of 60.00 ft.
to an iron pin; thence westerly parallel to the south line of
Nettmore Ave. S. E. a distance of 151.0 feet to an iron pin; thence
northerly parallel to the west line of 3rd St. S. E. a distance of
60.00 feet to an existing iron fence post; thence easterly along the
south line of Nettmore Ave. S. E. a distance of 151.0 feet to the
place of beginning containing 0.24 acres.

DESCRIPTION FOR C.L. 49, 50, and LOT NO. 10905

Known as and being Outlet Nos. 49 and 50 and Lot No. 10905 in
the City of Massillon, Ohio according to the present numbering of lots
in said City and being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of the south line
of C.L. 49 and the west line of 3rd St. S. E., said point being the true
place of beginning of the tract here-in described; thence S $70^{\circ}45'$ W
391.30 feet to an iron pin on the southwest corner of C.L. 49; thence
N $19^{\circ}57'$ W 572.30 feet to an iron pin on the south line of Walnut
Rd. S. E., also being the northwest corner of Lot No. 10905; thence
N $70^{\circ}35'$ E along the south line of Walnut Rd. S. E. 251.50 feet to the
northeast corner of Lot No. 10905; thence S $19^{\circ}15'$ E 271.92 feet to a
point; thence N $70^{\circ}35'$ E 146.50 feet to an iron pin on the west line of
3rd St. S. L.; thence S $19^{\circ}15'$ E along the west line of 3rd St. S. E.
301.85 feet to the place of beginning containing 4.28 acres.
