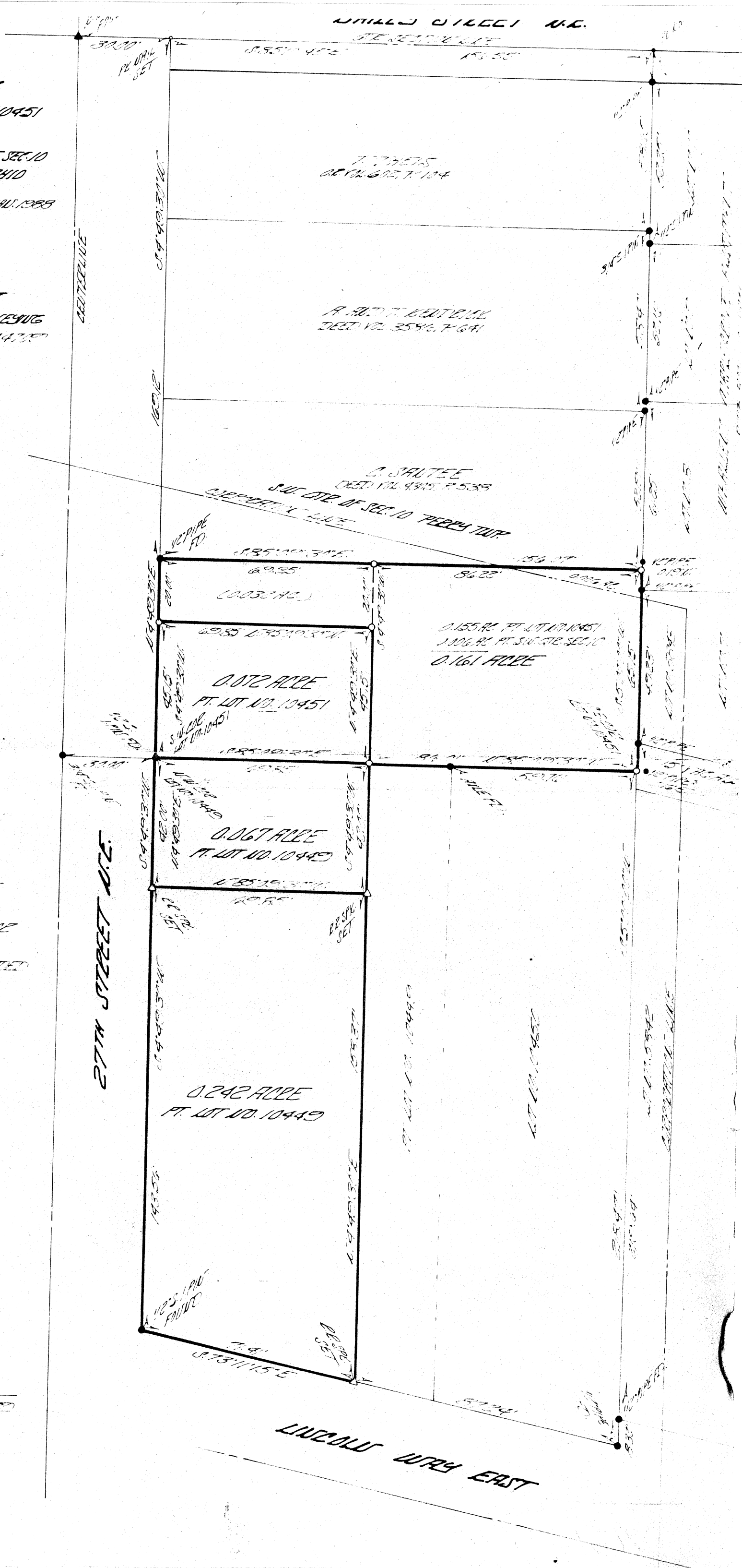


LINCOLN WAY EAST

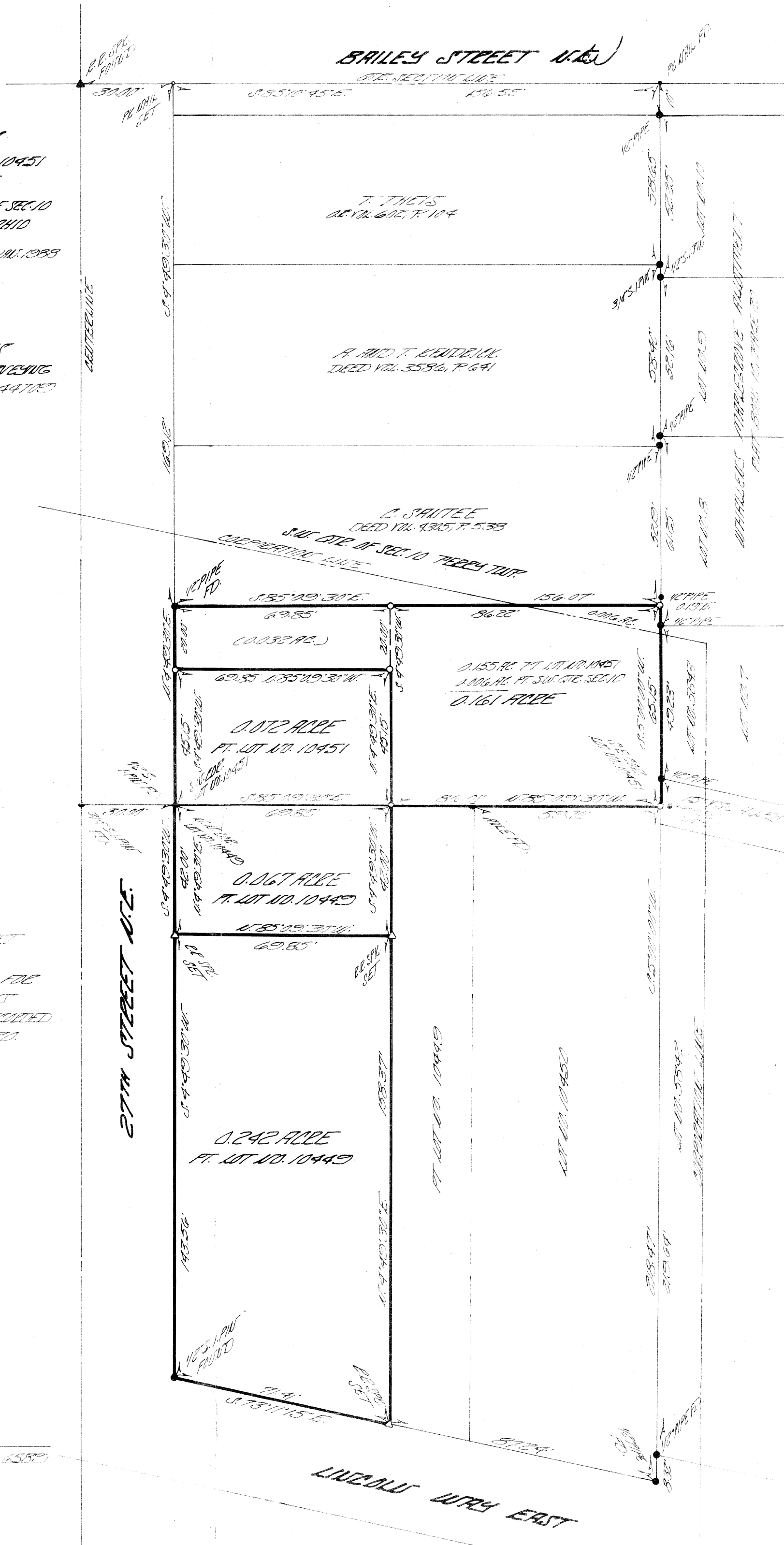

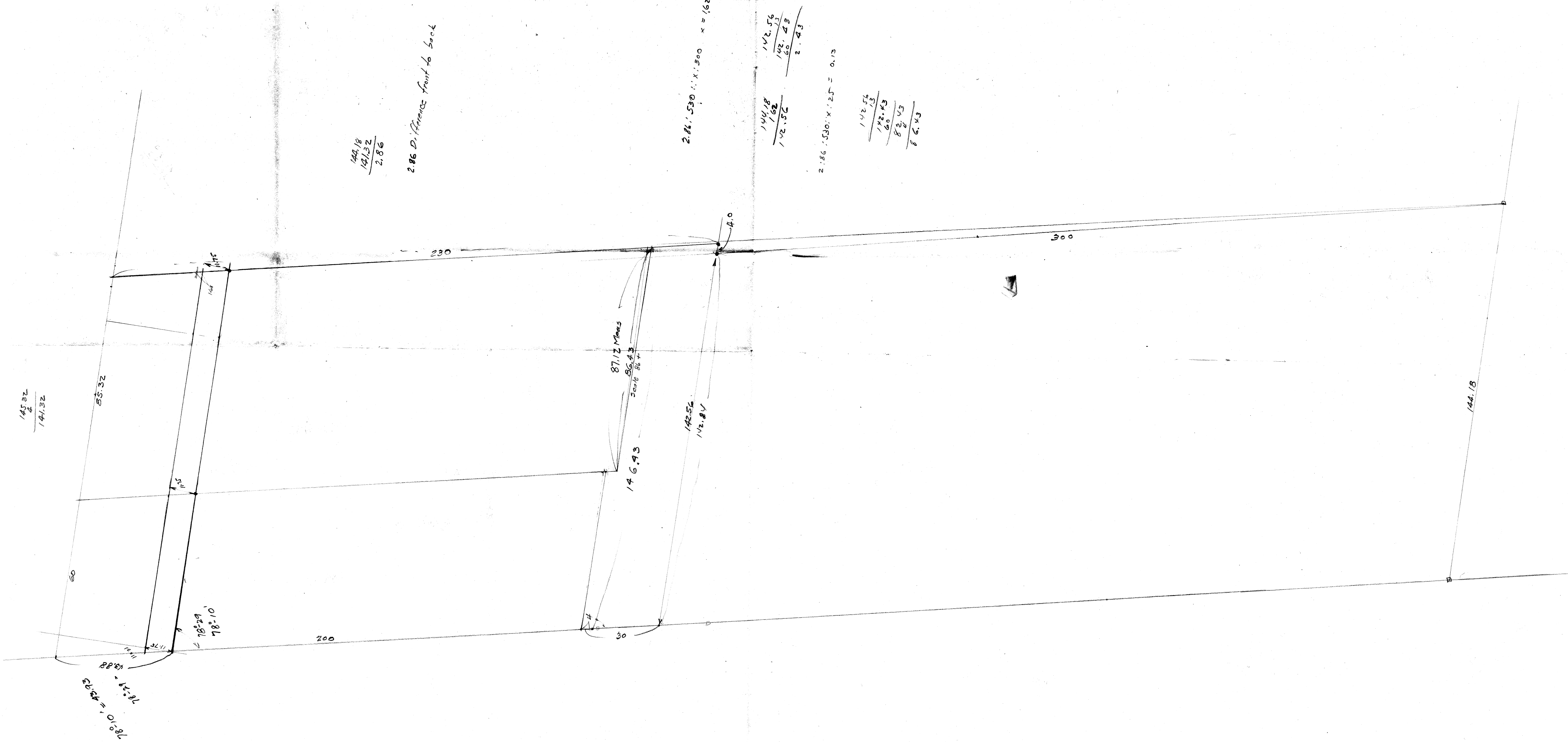

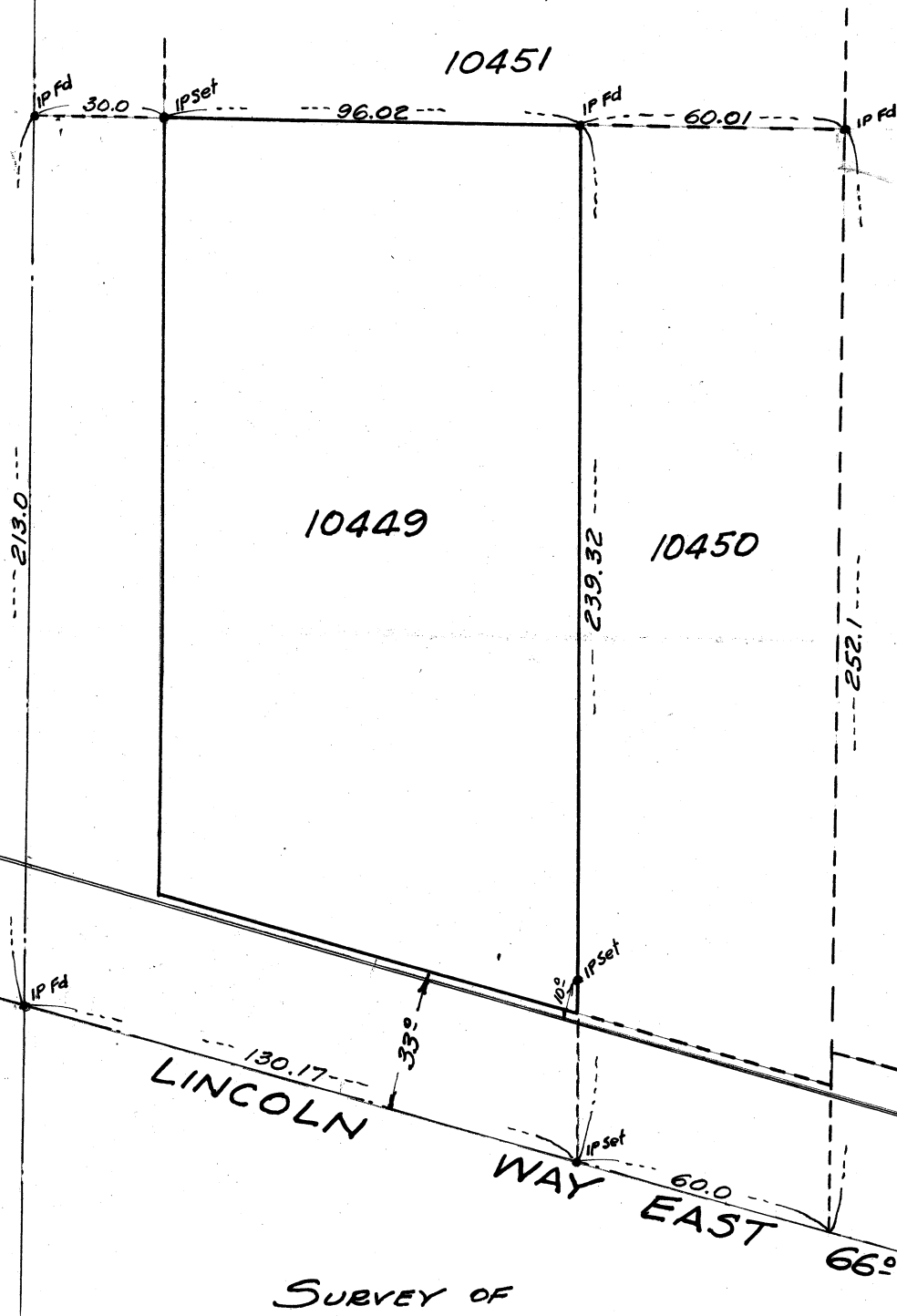

Dear Mr. Rice:

You will recall the case of Boron v. Lemmon, involving lots numbers 10449 and 10450 on Lincoln Way, East. I have represented Miss Boron.

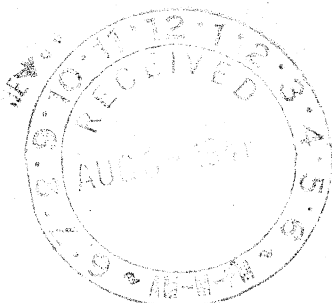
Judge Sweitzer, following the trial of this case, held that in order to determine the disputed boundary line between the properties we should start at the point on the north line 60 feet west of the northeast corner of lot 10450, draw a line parallel with the east line of lot 10450 and the west line of lot 10449 to Lincoln Way, East. Now I understand that Burt Stoner, representing the Lemmons, has put a pin along the north boundary line of Lincoln Way, East, fixing this point.

Miss Boron has authorized me to have you check the location of this pin and if it is correct, so advise me and then give me the front measurement, that is, the Lincoln Way frontage, of her lot. I want this to incorporate in the journal entry so that there never can be any dispute in the event the City improves the street in front and so as to fix Miss Boron's exact frontage.

Will you please do this at your earliest convenience and send me your bill with your report.
