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DESCRIPTION

PART OF O.L. 24

(Massillon Rubber Co.)

Located in the City of Massillon, Stark County, Ohio and being part of O.L. 24 and further described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin, said iron pin being the intersection of the west line of an unnamed 20', north-south alley and the south Right-of-Way line of a 66' Right-of-Way of the Wheeling & Lake Erie Railroad;

Thence S19°27'E along the west line of the 20' unnamed north-south alley, 335.44' to an iron pin;

Thence S68°19'53"W a distance of 142.02' to an iron pin;

Thence N34°35'W a distance of 56.84' to an iron pin;

Thence N19°07'W a distance of 62.98' to an iron pin;

Thence N70°53'E a distance of 9.0' to an iron pin;

Thence N19°07'W a distance of 213.87' to an iron pin, said pin being on the south Right-of-Way line of a 66' Right-of-Way line of the Wheeling & Lake Erie Railroad;

Thence N64°18'30"E along the south Right-of-Way line of the Wheeling & Lake Erie Railroad, a distance of 48.27' to an iron pin, said iron pin also being the point of curvature of a curve to the right;

Thence N68°12'E along the chord of said curve whose radius is 604.27', arc length of 98.34' and whose central angle is 9°19'30", a distance of 98.24' to the true place of beginning of the parcel herein described, containing 1.1547 acres, more or less.

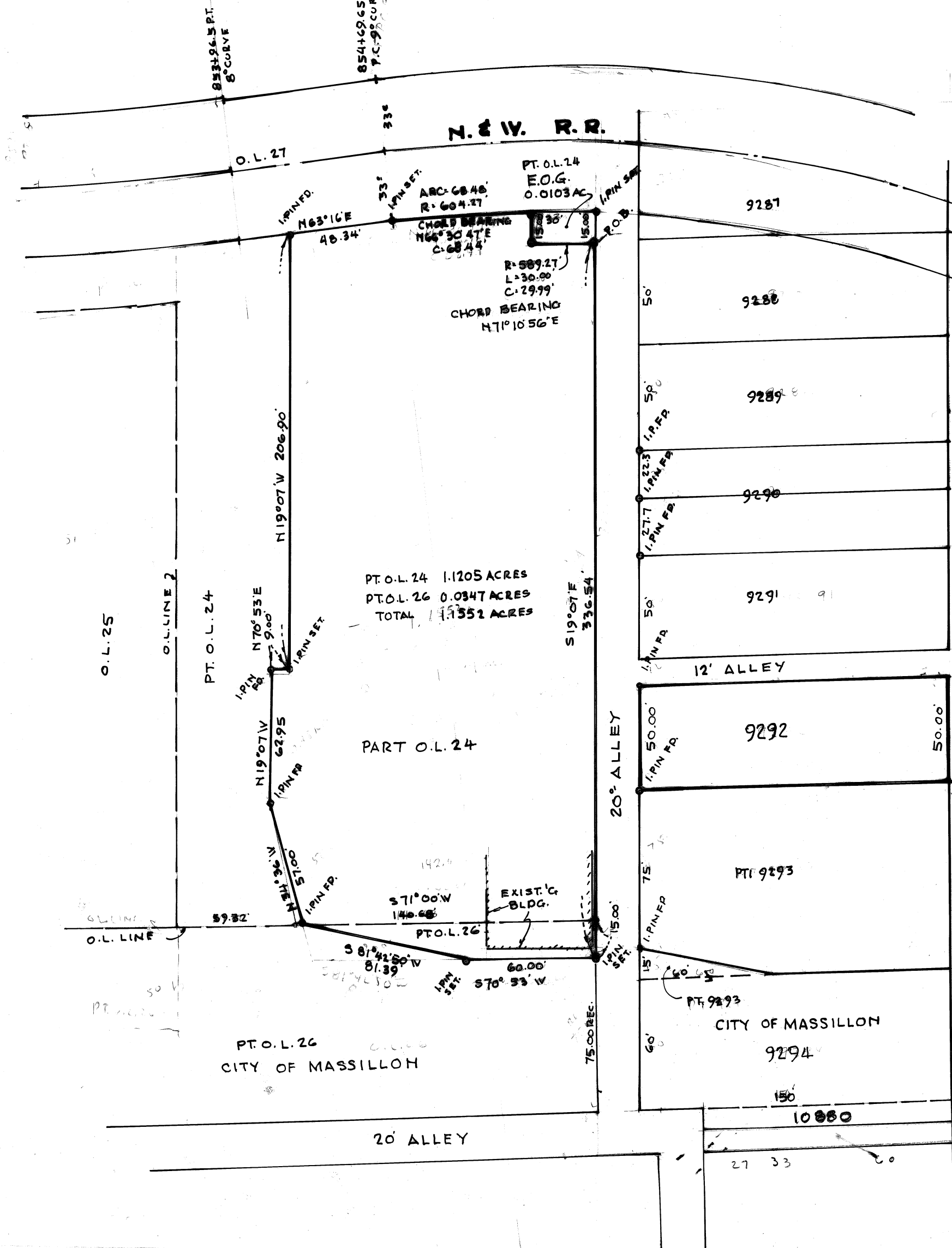
