## **PART OF LOTS 13898 and 13899 IN THE CITY OF MASSILLON**

Located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Perry Township (T-10, R-9), County of Stark and State of Ohio and being part of Lots 13898 and 13899 in the City of Massillon and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron bar at the northwest corner of Lot 13898 in said City of Massillon; Thence S  $88^{\circ}14'10''$  E, along the north line of said lot, a distance of 128.77 feet to an iron bar; said iron bar being the true place of beginning of the tract of land herein described:

- 1) Thence continuing along the north line of Lots 13898 and 13899, S  $88^{\circ}14'10''$  E, a distance of 110.49 feet to an iron bar;
- 2) Thence S  $00^{\circ}20'10''$  E, a distance of 135.69 feet to a point on a curve, said point being on the north right-of-way of Hamilton Street N.E. [50 feet wide];
- 3) Thence along the north right-of-way of said Hamilton Street and along the arc of a curve having a radius of 784.97 feet, a chord of 99.93 feet, a chord bearing of S  $85^{\circ}30'13''$  W, and a central angle of  $07^{\circ}17'57''$ , a distance of 100.00 feet to an iron bar;
- 4) Thence N  $04^{\circ}31'05''$  W, a distance of 147.38 feet to the true place of beginning and containing 0.339 acre, more or less, as determined by Friedl and Harris, Inc., Engineers and Surveyors of North Canton, Ohio in May, 1977.

The above mentioned lots formerly Lot 9 and Lot 8 respectively, of Normandy Allotment No. 2 as recorded in Plat Book 37, Page 64 of the Stark County Records of Plats.
