

Situated in the Township of Perry, County of Stark, and State of Ohio, and known as being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section No. 6, Twp. 10 (Perry) R. No. 9, Stark County, Ohio, Beginning at a point on the center line of North Mill Street, extended, 1718.5 feet South 50° West from an iron pin at the intersection of said center line of the road and the Township Line; thence South 50° West along said center line 50.0 feet; thence North 87° 12' West, 180.0 feet; thence North 50° East, 50.0 feet; thence South 87° 12' East, 180.0 feet to the place of beginning.

The South portion of the above described premises is now known as being Lot No. 10160 in the City of Massillon, Stark County, Ohio, having a frontage of 28.25 feet on North Mill Street, Ext., (now known as being First Street N. E.), and extends Westerly 180 feet uniform width, in said City.

Being the same premises conveyed to Home Owners' Loan Corporation by Sheriff's Deed dated the 31st day of August, 1938, and recorded in Volume 1219, page 225, of Stark County Records.
