Dear Sir:

As affecting the annexation of certain areas to the corporation of Massillon, there is herewith submitted a report dealing with the extension of sewerage facilities thereto.

The areas of concern are described in Ordinance #2109, September 2, 1924, and are outlined upon a city map of "Proposed Annexations" reproduced hereinafter.

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The questions of reference and generalized response thereto are:

1: ARE THE SANITARY TRUNK SEWERS OF MASSILLON OF CAPACITY AND LOCATION SUITABLE FOR EXTENDING SERVICE TO THESE AREAS?

Answer: The sanitary trunk sewers of Massillon now built, under construction or projected, are the normal and economic outlets for the areas of concern. These sewers are of adequate capacity. Further, the location fixed for future sewage treatment is favorably sited for service to all the area in question.

2: WHAT TRUNK SEWER EXTENSIONS WOULD BE REQUIRED TO REASONABLY SERVE THESE AREAS, AND WHAT WOULD BE THE COST?

Answer: There would be required the construction of five main sewers or extensions thereof. It would also be necessary to build thirteen sewer lines of minor nature. The aggregate entire cost of this construction would be \$130,000 and subdivided as follows:

East End and Sippo Heights	\$ 31,050
North End	9,700
Brookfield and West Main Street	44,600
Columbia Heights-West Park	22,400
Forest Avenue	<u>20,000</u>
