

Description of Areas Projected for Addition to the City.

The areas which it is proposed to annex to the Massillon Corporation and, consequently, those of concern in this report border the City on the east, north and west. They are located, chiefly, adjoining through roads which run from Massillon. This area in gross comprises about 1,810 Acres. The present corporate area of Massillon is about 2,400 Acres, consequently, the additions provide for an increase of 75.5% of the present corporate area.

General locations are exhibited on the small scale plat hereto attached and are also particularly listed in the accompanying table.

1: East End and Sippo Heights; a strip about 1 mile long and $\frac{1}{4}$ mile wide, extending south from the Canton Road.	473 Acres	Wetmore Trunk Sippo Trunk
2: North End Area; lying between North Front Street and North Akron Street, and extending about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile north of the present city limits.	215 Acres	North End Trunk Sewer
3: Brookfield Addition; an area $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles long and $\frac{1}{4}$ mile wide, located along Wooster Street Extension.	480 Acres	Wooster Trunk (2 branches)
4: West Main Street Addition; a block less than $\frac{1}{4}$ mile square lying north of West Main Street Extension.	123 Acres	Howell's Avenue, branch of Wooster Trunk.
5: Columbia Heights West Park; an area inclusive of the two named allotments and also extending westward to Pigeon Run Road.	388 Acres	Tuscarawas River Wooster Trunk.
6: Forest Avenue Addition; a small block which carries the easterly boundary of the City to Grape Street.	132 Acres	Tuscarawas River.

Note: Where a Trunk Sewer is given as the outlet, such is a Trunk Sewer of the City of Massillon.
