

Forest Avenue
(See Plat A4282.7 and Profile A4282.12)

This area lies between South Erie Street and Grape Street.

Sewerage for the district was included in the 1923 Report, but has been amplified by the inclusion of a cross drain to run from Johnson Street to Grape Street. It is assumed that further extensions will be provided by dedication of streets.

The intersection of Forest Avenue and Grape Street properly drains to a watershed other than that provided for herein. Drainage can, however, be carried west in Forest Avenue by cutting through the summit in that street.

Additional expansion of this district is possible on the east, and to moderate extent along South Erie Street. The sewers outlined are ample for this.

The estimated cost of these trunks is:

<u>Trunk #9: From Tuscarawas River to Bantz Street near Lincoln Avenue.</u>	6120 lin. ft. 12-in. Sewer	\$16,500
<u>Trunk #9A: A branch of Trunk #9 between Johnson and Grape Streets</u>	1530 lin. ft. 8-in. Sewer	3,500
TOTAL--Forest Avenue	7650 lin. ft.	\$20,000

Trunk #9A is designed to serve area not now developed.
